Analysis on using Post Legislative scrutiny of environment and climate legislation in Macedonia

Aim of the activity

To produce an analysis on how using Post Legislative Scrutiny of environment and climate legislation could improve implementation in North Macedonia.

Specific goals of the analysis

1. To collect available data and analyze existing and draft legislative procedures and relevant environment/climate legislation in North Macedonia

Under this chapter, the analysis should answer the following questions:

- What are the existing legislative procedures in the country?
- What are the key issues related to implementation of environment and climate legislation in the country?
- Are there any plans or procedures already available to improve implementation of relevant legislation?

2. To showcase how Post Legislative Scrutiny can be used to improve implementation of environment and climate legislation

The analysis should build on existing legislative and governance mechanisms for implementation of legislation specifically related to environment and climate change in the country.

The analysis should provide the answer to the question: How can PLS improve implementation of environment and climate legislation in the country?

3. To promote the results of the study via meetings with relevant stakeholders and decision makers

Content and format

The study should be prepared in English and Macedonian language, between 30 and 50 A4 pages and contain tables, references and graphs as necessary.
